Administration	£9100	Includes clerk's salary, tax and expenses, clerk & councillor training, meetings, insurance, subscriptions and auditing.
The Tyning	£5700	Grass cutting, hedge cutting and repayment of the Public Works Loan Board.
LED upgrade	£3700	Upgrading of 11 street lamps to LEDs (1 of 2 payments).
Street cleaning	£3000	Includes clearing mud and debris, keeping drains unblocked, strimming of vegetation around the village.
Street lighting	£2700	Electricity supply and maintenance.
The Cemetery	£2220	Includes grass cutting, clearing vegetation from headstones and fence repairs.
Memorial Hall	£1850	Annual donation and a contribution to car park works.
Communications	£1500	Website and two editions of the Freshford Newsletter.
Station gardening	£600	A gardener helped volunteers with work at the station.
Assets	£550	New bin by the Memorial Hall.
